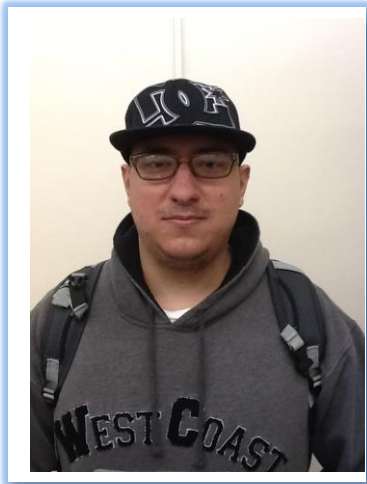


From Frustration to a Future of Possibilities
