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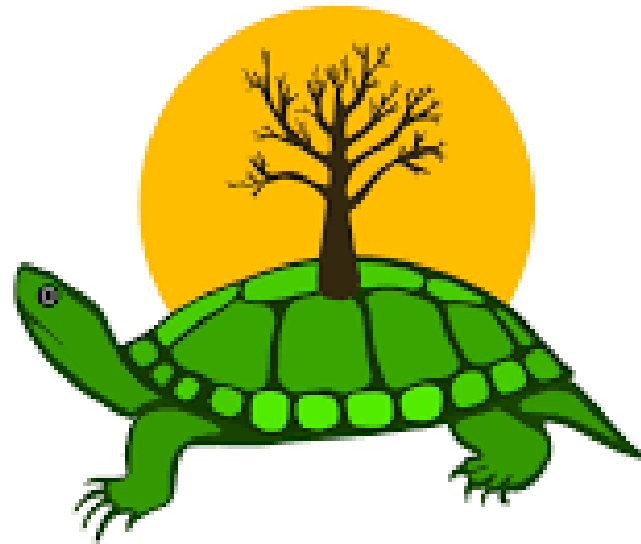

Indigenous Institutes (IIs)

Overview: IIs were created to address the lack of educational opportunities in Indigenous communities

History: Indigenous students were under supported in their learning and wanted to have a say

Indigenous Institutes Sector: Ontario has 9 IIs that are governed & operated by Indigenous nations

Maawndoo Kinoomaagaswin (Ontario Literacy and Basic Skills - MCU)

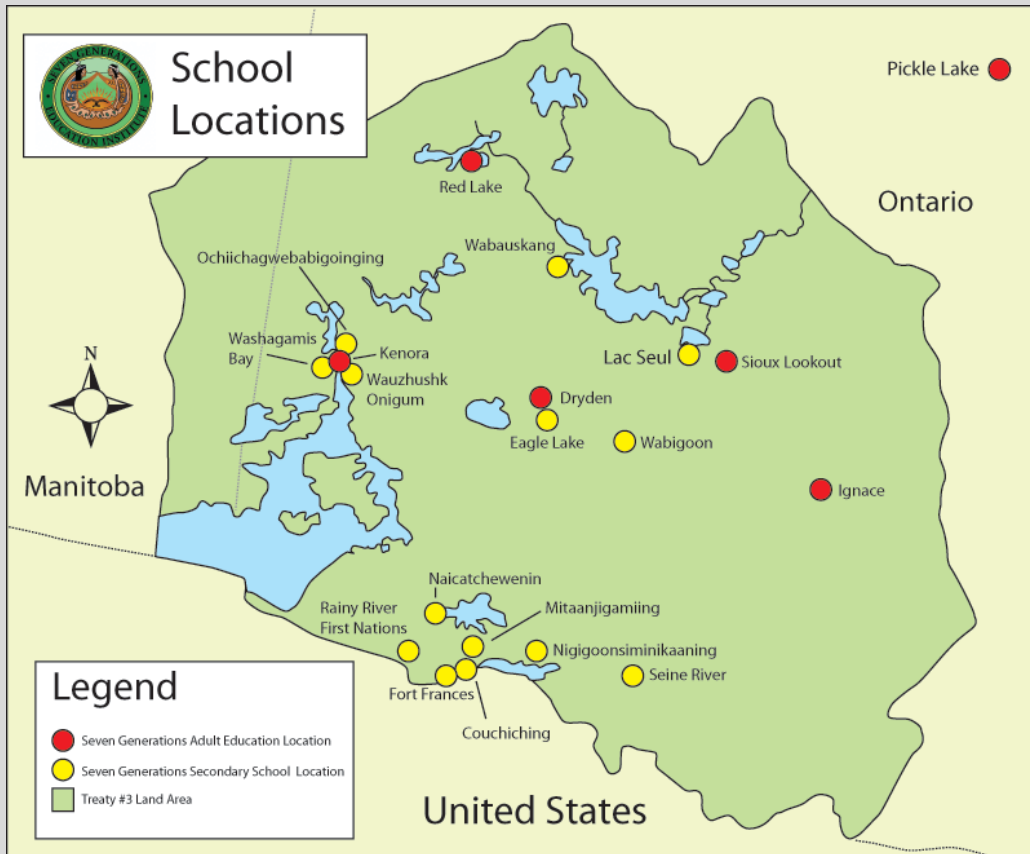
- Serves learners who have goals to successful transition to employment, post-secondary, apprenticeships, secondary school, and increase their independence; assists adults in Ontario to develop and apply communication, numeracy, interpersonal, and digital skills

Secondary School (Private School / Provincial Status)

- Ministry accredited and inspected secondary school program (continuous intake/admissions) for adult learners wishing to complete their secondary school diploma or attain prerequisite courses for college admission; also includes dual credits; OYAP;
