Findings from Phase 1:

- Adult Education programming needs to be better advertised
- Capacity for adult education needs to be built in the Superior-Greenstone region
- PLAR needs to be better understood and delivered consistently

Phase 2 – Next Steps

- Advertising campaign to be launched with centralized phone number
- Mentoring and support for Superior-Greenstone Board to be provided
- Relationships amongst other adult ed providers, employment centres, Indigenous education authorities, employment agencies, OW to be expanded
- 106 Contact North sites to provide access to e-learning at LAEC

Phase 2 – Next Steps Continued..

- Dual credits being offered locally in partnership with college
- PLAR training and mentorship through both LAEC and the province for the region
- Pilot projects with First Nations communities (both on and off reserve) to be initiated
- Regional guidance position to be developed to serve all the sites in the region, including partnerships with KKETS
