




What does the OeLC do?





OELC INTERNAL GOVERNANCE & LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE

- Executive Director Leads and Manages the team. Responsible for planning, reporting, financing, development; communication.
- Technical Director Technical, software and developer liaison, Professional learning. Privacy Officer and CIO. Exec Director coverage
- Program Coordinator Field ops and meetings; Pedagogy, Professional Development and Learning, Research.
- Tech Support and Program Facilitator-Help desk, professional learning, software support, Privacy co-Ordinator, Faith based education advisor. Tech director coverage.



Professional Development and Pedagogy (PD&P) Steering Committee



- Leadership Committee
- 4 representatives from each region 2 from Public and 2 from Catholic
- Gather member voice from region and share at monthly meetings
- 6 different initiatives
- BUT ... how do we meet the needs of our member boards?
- And how do we share the wealth of knowledge that exists within regions, boards and individuals?



Gathering Member Voice



- Survey sent out to member boards early in the school year
- What are topics of high interest and/or the greatest learning need among your eTeachers?
- What are the most prevalent challenges experienced by eTeachers?
- When is the best time of day to offer professional development for eTeachers and other eStaff?
- Rank different types of professional development to indicate how likely they would be accessed/used/attended by your eStaff.



Bootcamps



- Facilitated by:
 - OeLC
 - Home board
 - Home region
 - Cross region
- Can be technical or pedagogical
- In-person, virtual or hybrid
- Allow an opportunity for teachers to learn, share and collaborate with colleagues



French Immersion Pilot Project



- Small boards have difficulty offering a breadth of French Immersion courses
- 3 stage French Immersion pilot:
 - Phase 1: Collaborate, Build Resources and Share (2023-24)
 - Phase 2: Phase 1 plus Course Building (2024-25)
 - Phase 3: Phase 1 & 2 plus Course Delivery (2025-26 +)



BOLTT Conferences



- Bringing Online Teams Together
- 2 Conferences per year:
 - Toronto Fall
 - Ottawa Spring (May 8-9, 2024)
- By online teams for online teams
- Our mission is to spark ideas, create connections, and accelerate learning supporting improved outcomes for education staff, teachers and learners.



Collaborative Inquiries



- The feedback from the Board Voice Survey will be used to determine a topic
- Starting with one Collaborative Inquiry in Semester 2
- Allows opportunities for staff to explore a topic more deeply with colleagues from across the province
- Cross board opportunities allow for new and more varied learning opportunities for all
- Potential expansion in future years



Student Voice Forum



- Surveying eLearning students Semester 2
 - What is working in their eLearning courses?
 - What is not working in their eLearning courses?
 - What improvements can we make to improve student experience and success in eLearning courses?
- Compile results
- Share with Consortium member boards
- Implementation of student voice suggestions beginning in 2024-25 school year
- Repeat the Student Voice Survey biennially





Pride & Pedagogy Webinar Series

- Monthly pedagogically-focussed webinar
- Topics determined from Board Voice Survey
- Guest hosts from member boards
- Interactive format:
 - Review and consolidation of learning from previous webinar
 - Small bite learning skill, concept or idea (recorded)
 - Differentiated Breakouts discuss and/or practice use
- Recorded sessions posted as VOD on Intranet for asynchronous access



Educate Engage Empower



- Table discussions with feedback:

- How has / could online learning support plans to transform the educational experience in your portfolio? (AESL/LBS/Credit/PSW/IILS / etc..)


