Pre-LINC / Waiting List Classes Pilot



- Orientation program since 2020-21 with 2 Orientation Teachers (15 hrs each/week) for 5 sites + online program
- Due to waitlists + request from IRCC, pilot proposed Dec. 2022
- Why:
 - 2 additional LINC sites April 2023
 - need for more support to onboard new clients (chromebook lending, training ++)
 - manage waitlist (negative impact of continuous enrolment on programming)
 - skill building and program readiness while waiting for a class



Project Outline

Expansion of Orientation

Orientation originally was to Tech Only

Now...

- Orientation to Site (for In Person clients)
- Orientation to "What they will learn" including PBLA
- Filling out of Needs Assessments
- Ensuring client has a Gmails, determine if client needs to borrow tech device, childcare.

New PreLINC (Waitlist) Classes

- Support and contact with clients on the waiting list
- Providing some basic info/instruction while waiting for a spot to open up
- Will regulate arrival of new clients in class to Mondays every two weeks (controlled intake)

Schedule

- Orientation Two weeks (Monday Thursday)
- PreLINC Waitlist Class Two Weeks (Monday Thursday)
- Fridays 1 hour class with Remaining PreLINC students who don't have a class yet

Orientation

- LINC and ESL
 - ESL must have a class
 - LINC max top 5 from waiting lists
 - No evening students
- Online and F2F Sessions
 - Online 1.5 hr online, one on one
 - F2F one 3 hr group session F2F by level
- 4 staff (15 hrs/wk) and additional help from Support Instructor Staff

New PreLINC (Waitlist) Classes

- Only LINC eligible students
- Online for both F2F and Online students
- Some F2F choose to opt out
- 3 AM Staff covering levels:
 - F, 1L, 2L
 - 1, 2
 - 3, 4, 5
- 1 PM Staff covering levels: 1L, 1, 2L, 2



Staff roles and responsibilities

- Registration Remove from HARTS waitlist and add to internal orientation lists
- 2. Orientation Teachers Send invitation to book appointments (Schoolinterviews.ca). Follow-up with calls.
- 3. Interpretation assistance from Childcare staff as needed.
- 4. Registration Move students from Orientation to a class or PreLINC
 - note: students remain in PreLINC until a seat becomes available
- 5. Report in I-Care for LINC eligible clients for both (i.e. Settlement and Orientation)





Initial Feedback on Pilot:

- Logistics the most difficult part of the process
- Communication needs to take multiple forms email, phone, different times of day
- Simple email communication is necessary:
 - Use "IMPORTANT" in subject line
 - Greeting must include student's name
- Phone from School board phone (Not from an unknown number/cell)
- Translate important information, eg. Movement from Orientation to Regular Class or Waitlist Class
 - Google Translate works for this if needed
 - Use of websites to voice information in first language for literacy students E.g. https://www.narakeet.com/languages/



*This process was very helpful in cleaning up waiting lists, eg. removing people who were no longer wanting a class or needed a class at another time because their circumstances had changed.




Curriculum PreLINC
