How to enter data in PS How to report data to OnSIS How to work through OnSIS errors Collection and entry of student data

- Ensure that all required data is collected for Ministry Reporting purposes per the Continuing Education Enrolment Registers Instructions <u>Enrolment register</u> <u>instructions | ontario.ca</u>
- Ensure that the student is registered and active in PowerSchool
- Ensure the that student is registered and active in a course in PowerSchool
- On the Ontario State/Province Screen, make sure that the "Mature" student box is checked.

PLAR Cumulative Tracking forms

•We use EDGE4 to track and complete our PLAR and to generate our PLAR Cumulative Tracking forms

•Every time PLAR credits are granted, and updated, a Cumulative tracking form is generated and sent to Student Data where the credits are entered into PowerSchool

•Cumulative Tracking forms are like Report Cards and must be kept in the student file/OSR (for audit) - in addition to being added into PowerSchool to generate funding

How to enter data in PowerSchool - 9/10 PLAR

- •When entering PLAR Credits into Historical Grades, use the MIDENT of the school where the student is registered and taking their course
- •Grade 9-10 PLAR
 - •Enter one by one (unless your board has it set up differently)
 - •Use appropriate Compulsory codes for each PLE99 credit granted
 - •Use the MIDENT of the school the student is registered and taking a course in
 - •Use the PLAR Type 5
 - •Enter PLAR Status Type "Not Appliable"
 - •Enter the same date for ALL PLAR granted in a month we use the last school day of each month to avoid issues with OCAS Upload.

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How to enter data in PowerSchool -11/12Mature PLAR

•When entering PLAR Credits into Historical Grades, use the MIDENT of the school where the student is registered and taking their course

- •Grade 11-12/Mature PLAR
 - •Enter one by one
 - •Use appropriate Compulsory codes for each credit granted
 - •Each Mature PLAR credit granted should have an active/current Ministry of Education course code
 - •Use the MIDENT of the school the student is registered and taking a course in
 - •Use the PLAR **Type 7**
 - •Enter PLAR Status Type "Not Appliable"
 - •Enter the same date for ALL PLAR granted in a month – we use the last school day of each month – to avoid issues with OCAS Upload.

Don't miss out on funding

•Even if a student only completes their initial assessment but does not complete PLAR Tests or the Mature PLAR process, you can add a PLE99 Credit with an earned credit value of Zero (0). This will generate funding of \$131 per the Technical Paper -<u>Education funding, 2023–24 | ontario.ca</u>

•Use the following:

- Earned Credit value = 0
- Potential Credit value = 1
- Credit Type/Compulsory Code "OPT"
- MIDENT = same as the school the student and course registration are in
- PLAR Type = 5
- Status Type = NA
- Make sure the student has an active school and course registration

How to report data to OnSIS

•PLAR Credits MUST be granted in the same school the student is active in

•Student must have a course enrolment – or no PLAR data will be added to the OnSIS File

•In PowerSchool, lock into the school you are creating the OnSIS .xml file for, navigate to Provincial Reports and choose "OnSIS Night School Submission"

•In OnSIS, lock into the school you're submitting data for, click on the "Data Collection" tab, click the "Upload Batch File" link and select the upload (.xml data) file.

•Once the file has processed in OnSIS, review your errors

•If the wrong PLAR Type is attached to the credit ex. PLE99 is created with a PLAR Type 7 – an error will be generated (or an 11-12 PLAR created with a PLAR Type 5 will also generate an error)

How to work through OnSIS errors

•In OnSIS, on the Batch File Results list click on the file that you want to look at/work on

•When the results detail page comes up, you can look at the summary results and at the bottom left, you can choose "Download Results" to **save** your ".OUT" file

•In PowerSchool, navigate to Provincial reports and select "OnSIS Error File Conversion", browse for your saved ".OUT" file and view/print the results

•On the next few pages, please find some sample errors and how to correct them

Make sure the student has the "Mature Flag" checked – make sure that they are eligible to be considered a Mature Student ie. Over 18 before December 31 of current school year and out of school for at least 10 consecutive months.
